



FIP MANDATORY POOL RULES

- **EVERYONE MUST HAVE THEIR FIP PHOTO ID CARD**

You must scan your card to enter the pool. These cards cannot be given to anyone else to use.

- **A SPLASH PASS IS REQUIRED TO BRING IN A NON-RESIDENT GUEST**

You are allowed to bring 6 guests maximum per household, per day (4 guests max on holidays). Only exception is at the Amenity Center pool Monday through Thursday (excludes holidays).

- **AN FIP RESIDENT MUST BE PRESENT WITH GUESTS AT ALL TIME**

You are not allowed to leave your guest alone on the pool deck for any reason, no matter what age. The only exception is if you pre-purchase a House Guest Pass at the Amenity Center office.

- **FOOD AND DRINK IS ALLOWED ONLY IN DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE POOL DECK**

You may bring food & drink (no alcohol or glass) onto the pool deck, but must eat in designated areas marked by signage. All coolers are subject to search. Please put all trash in waste bins.

- **NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL**

Outside alcohol is not permitted to be brought into the facility. If caught with outside alcohol, you will be asked to leave for the day and possibly put your amenity usage in jeopardy.

- **SLIDES ARE FOR GOING DOWN ONLY**

The Thunder Bucket feature at the Splash Park is for our residents 8 years of age and under. There is no climbing up the slide at any time or sliding head first

- **GIANT SLIDE IS FOR TRAINED SWIMMERS ONLY**

The Giant Slide at the Splash Park is for our advanced swimmers over 40 inches. You cannot catch your child at the bottom of the slide. They have to be able to swim unassisted.

- **FIP RESIDENTS AGED 13 ARE ABLE TO ATTEND THE POOL WITHOUT SUPERVISION**

They cannot, however, bring in a guest. Proof of age may be required.

- **NO RAFTS, TUBES, BOOGIE BOARDS, OR MERMAID TAILS**

Only infant safety floats with feet holes, life vests (US Coastguard approved), or noodles are permitted.

- **AMERICAN ACADEMY OF PEDIATRICS SWIM POLICY ENFORCED**

Never leave a child alone in or near the pool

Close supervision by a responsible adult is required

Provide arm's length or touch supervision for non-swimmers

FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THE (AAP) SWIM POLICY

- First Offense- Verbal Warning

- 2nd Offense- Written Warning

- 3rd Offense- Loss of pool privileges for a designated period

- **SWIM ABILITY DETERMINATION**

All minors or under Age 12 will be swim tested once per season. Colored wristbands will be worn upon completion

- **NO RUNNING**

- **NO DIVING**

All entry into the pool must be feet first.

- **ONLY SQUISHY BALLS ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL**

No footballs, volleyballs, baseballs, etc.

- **NO SMOKING ON ANY CDD PROPERTY**
